## MEMORANDUM

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**August 21, 2001**  
**Agenda Actions**

The regular meeting of the Board of Cuyahoga County Commissioners was called to order at 1:57 P.M. Commissioners Jane L. Campbell, Jimmy Dimora and Tim McCormack were in attendance.

The August 21<sup>st</sup> meeting resulted in the following actions:

- Item #1 was held at the request of the Board pending additional information.
- Items #2 – 5 were considered in order and adopted by unanimous vote.
- At this time, consideration moved to the public hearings advertised for 2:00 P.M.

Commissioner Dimora officially opened the final hearing for the vacation of Grayton Road from Brookpark Road to Interstate 480 in the City of Cleveland at 2:06 P.M. by restating the project. He then recognized Scott Graham, representative of County Engineer Robert Klaiber, Jr., who spoke briefly to the project and called for public comment. Hearing none, Commissioner Dimora officially closed the public hearing at 2:12 P.M. and the Clerk of the Board was directed to read the recommendation:

“Adopting a resolution approving and accepting Plat M-4935 for the vacation of Grayton Road from Brookpark Road to Interstate 480 in the City of Cleveland.”

The recommendation was adopted by unanimous vote.

The next hearing, a hearing of objections for County Improvement No. 1460, Phase II, a waterline and appurtenances in Sharp Road from Sprague Road to Schady Road in Olmsted Township, County Sewer District No. 14, was officially opened by Commissioner Dimora at 2:14 P.M. Commissioner Dimora

restated the project and recognized Ruth Langsner, Cuyahoga County Sanitary Engineer, who briefly spoke to the project. At this time, Commissioner Dimora called for public comment and several residents spoke for or against the project.

Commissioner Dimora called for further comment, and Harold Babbitt, attorney for the project, recommended that the public hearing be continued to a date certain. The Clerk of the Board recommended the public hearing for this project be continued to Tuesday, September 11, 2001 at 2:00 P.M. and the recommendation was adopted by unanimous vote.

- Consideration returned to the normal order of the agenda and Item #6 was considered and adopted by unanimous vote.
- Item #7 was read into the record; however, there were no recommendations offered for consideration.
- Items #8 - 19 were considered in order and adopted by unanimous vote.
- At this time, a motion to move into Executive Session to consider the employment of a public employee was made and adopted by unanimous vote.
- Following Executive Session, and with no further business to be brought before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 6:05 P.M.
