RESOLUTION

Resolution: The Board of County Commissioners of Cuyahoga County, Ohio takes profound pride and deep personal pleasure in supporting the passage of House Bill 290 and Senate Bill 127, also known as the Ohio Prescription Drug Fair Pricing Act.

WHEREAS, Representative Dale Miller and Senator Robert Hagan introduced House Bill 290 and Senate Bill 127 that creates the Ohio Prescription Drug Fair Pricing Act; and

WHEREAS, one of four Americans, including 2.2 million Ohioans have no prescription drug coverage; and

WHEREAS, these identical bills seek to provide prescription coverage for Ohioans who are uninsured, underinsured, or have limited prescription coverage; and

WHEREAS, these bills would provide a voluntary prescription program for all Ohioans at no additional cost to taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Prescription Drug Fair Pricing Act would enable the Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services the ability to negotiate discounts on prescriptions much like the federal government does for veterans and Health Maintenance Organizations do for their members; and

WHEREAS, even after paying the administrative costs of the program, it is predicted that the discount to consumers would be 50% to 60%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Cuyahoga County, Ohio that said Board hereby supports the passage of House Bill 290 and Senate Bill 127, also known as the Ohio Prescription Drug Fair Pricing Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board be, and she is, hereby instructed to transmit a copy of this resolution to Jane Fumich, Director, Department of Senior and Adult Services.
