

RESOLUTION

Proclaiming Support for Issue 2, the Cleveland Public Library Levy Issue.

WHEREAS, the Cleveland Public Library, the Peoples University, enriches the community with a major research, information, cultural and educational resource for our citizens regardless of their income, regardless of where they live, regardless of their age, regardless of their background.

AND, WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has cut the funding to local libraries by five million dollars in the last two years and proposes additional cuts in the upcoming State budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Cuyahoga County, Ohio believes Issue 2 is a sound investment and on behalf of the Cleveland Public Library, we urge the residents of the City of Cleveland to support Issue 2 on May 6th.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board be and she is, hereby instructed to transmit one copy of this resolution to Rick Werner, Interim Deputy County Administrator.
