

RESOLUTION

Supporting the City of Cleveland's proposal to host the 2008
Republican National Convention.

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland has submitted a proposal to host the 2008
Republican National Convention and is one of four cities under consideration by the
Republican National Party.

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland's proposal indicates that it is able to meet the
Republican National Party's requirements for hosting the 2008 Republican National
Convention.

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland's, Cuyahoga County's and Northeast Ohio's
Metroparks, waterfront activities, world-class institutions and unique ethnic
neighborhoods provide ample opportunities for the estimated 50,000 conventioners to
recreate, educate and shop.

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County pledges to provide any and all assistance to the
City of Cleveland in preparing and hosting the Republican National Convention.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Cuyahoga County encourages the
Republican National Party to select Cleveland as the host City for the 2008 Republican
National Convention.

hereby instructed to transmit a copy of this resolution to Frank Jackson, Mayor, City of
Cleveland and Hugh B. Shannon, Government Services Coordination Manager,
Administrator's Office.
