

RESOLUTION

Approving an Emergency Declaration due to severe weather conditions, which impacted communities in Cuyahoga County commencing on June 22, 2006.

-----

WHEREAS, beginning on June 22, 2006, severe weather caused damage in several communities in Cuyahoga County.

WHEREAS, the property, lives and well-being of citizens have been impacted by this event.

WHEREAS, the financial, human and material resources of the political subdivisions and individuals within the affected communities have been taxed beyond their normal capability.

WHEREAS, Section 5502 of the Ohio Revised Code describes the responsibilities and process for the County to submit a Declaration in order for State and/or Federal resources to be requested to mitigate the impact of the emergency conditions.

WHEREAS, several communities in Cuyahoga County have declared local disasters and are requesting support and approval of the Board of County Commissioners for an emergency declaration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, that based upon the information received from communities in Cuyahoga County regarding damage resulting from the severe weather event commencing on June 22, 2006 that an Emergency Declaration is approved and that State and/or Federal resources are requested to mitigate the impact of this Emergency. This Resolution shall apply from the date the storm commenced continuing through the closing date, which will be determined based upon the damage assessment process and program that will be completed by the State and/or Federal government.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board be, and she is, hereby instructed to transmit a copy of this resolution to Steven Terry, Director, Department of Justice Affairs and Murray Withrow, Manager, Department of Justice Affairs/Emergency Services Division.

On Motion of Commissioner Hagan, seconded by Commissioner Jones, the foregoing resolution was duly adopted.
