

**RESOLUTION**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO REPLACE AND REDUCE BY 0.1 MILLS AN EXISTING 3.0 MILL TAX LEVY FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPLEMENTING GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS FOR HEALTH AND HUMAN OR SOCIAL SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF FOUR (4) YEARS, AND REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE COUNTY AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY THAT REPLACEMENT AND REDUCTION LEVY.**

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WHEREAS, on March 2, 2004, the electors of the County approved a 3.0 mill renewal levy for the purpose of supplementing the general fund appropriations for health and human or social services for a period of three (3) years, which levy will have its last collection in calendar year 2007.

WHEREAS, this Board finds that it is necessary to replace and reduce by 0.1 mills that levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of supplementing the general fund appropriations for health and human or social services for a period of four (4) years.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Division (B) of Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, in order to submit the question of a tax levy pursuant to Sections 5795.19, 5705.191 and 5705.192 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Board must request that the County Auditor certify (i) the total current tax valuation of the County and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the levy.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Division (B) of Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, upon receipt of a certified copy of a resolution of this Board declaring the necessity of the tax, stating its purpose, whether it is an additional levy or a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax, and the Section of the Ohio Revised Code authorizing its submission to the electors, and requesting such certification, the County Auditor is to certify the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the proposed levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioner of the County of Cuyahoga, Ohio:

Section 1: This Board declares that it is necessary to replace for a period of four years, a portion of an existing 3.0 mill ad valorem tax outside of the ten-mill limitation and reduce such levy by 0.1 mills to constitute a tax levy at a rate not to exceed 2.9 mills for the benefit of the County for the purpose of supplementing the general fund appropriations for health and human or social services for a period of four (4) years, and that it intends to submit the question of that replacement and reduction tax levy to the electors at an election on November 7, 2006, as authorized by Sections 5705.19, 5705.191 and 5705.192 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 2. This Board requests the County Auditor to certify to it both (i) the total current tax valuation of the County and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the 2.9 mill replacement and reduction levy specified in Section 1.**

**Section 3. The Clerk of the Board is authorized and directed to deliver promptly to the County Auditor a certified copy of this Resolution.**

**Section 4. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were held, in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.**

**Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.**

**On Motion of Commissioner Hagan, seconded by Commissioner Jones, the foregoing resolution was duly adopted.**
