WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Department of Children & Family Services placed 346 children in adoptive homes during this past year; however, many more children continue their search for a loving, permanent family.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Cuyahoga County, Ohio is pleased to officially recognize the many persons and families who have shared their mentoring and parenting talents, as well as, providing permanent homes on behalf of our most vulnerable citizens.
